THE ICELANDIC HEALTH CARE SYSTEM


Icelandic population 388.000 (Jan. 2023)

- Good clinical results in comparison to other OECD nations





Figure 3.14. Cancer incidence (estimated), 2020, and mortality, 2019




LOW HEART ATTACK AND ISCHAEMIC HEART



Figure 3.12. Stroke mortality, 2019 and change 2000-19 (or nearest year)














THE ICELANDIC HEALTH CARE SYSTEM

Created by a series of mergers In 1996, 2000 and 2011







NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING LANDSPÍTALI HOSPITAL CARE AT LANDSPÍTALI






AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY (DAYS)







NUMBER OF VISITS TO EMERGENCY UNITS



INPATIENTS; MAIN DIAGNOSTIC CATHEGORIES




